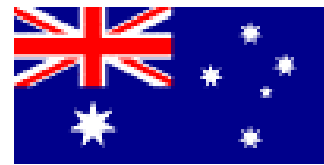


The Parliamentary Education Office (PEO) has created an Image Library for use by teachers and students. This is limited to:

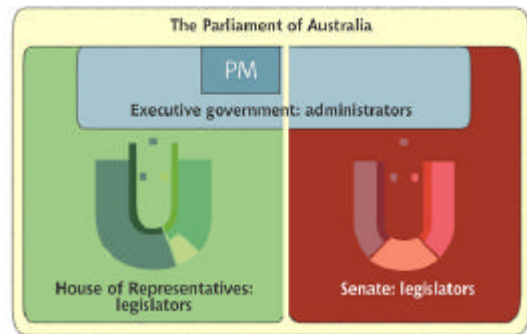
- Personal use including leisure and research activities

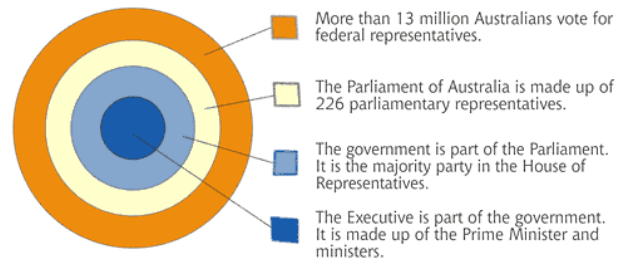


ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARLIAMENT
